An Overview of Concrete Masonry Manufacturing & Construction

Presentation Description:

This presentation covers a basic overview of concrete masonry systems and materials; including how concrete masonry units are manufactured, masonry terminology, masonry mortars, masonry grouts, and construction practices and requirements. (1 hr. LU, HSW)

SESSION TWO

Avoiding Cracks in Clay Masonry

Presentation Description:

Although rarely seen in single-family houses, movement joints are used to prevent damage to many materials, including masonry, in other structures. Learn what causes movement, how much

movement to expect in clay masonry veneers, how to control that movement, and where to place movement joints to avoid cracking and other damage. Learn why a C.J. is not a M.J or an E.J. Learn where to place wall ties, how wall ties are specified, and what materials to use. Sealants, an integral part of a movement joint, are also discussed. (1 hr. LU, HSW)

SESSION THREE

Troubleshooting Masonry Construction

Presentation Description:

An overview of procedures for identifying and preventing problems, and maintaining and restoring the appearance and functionality of masonry and the masonry-veneer building envelope. (1 hr. LU, HSW)
